Introduction

UK Road Safety has for some time considered the number of child fatalities and injuries whilst travelling in a car completely unacceptable and feel that it is time that someone made the public aware of this growing problem. Whilst you may feel that you are safe driving your children around in a car, do you consider the danger you are placing your children in when they are being driven by someone else, do you know how good their driving is? Before you employ someone you check the Criminal Records Bureau, Sex Offenders Register, Qualifications, Visa's, Previous Employment references, the one thing you don't check is driving ability, you just trust that if they hold a licence they should be ok—is that enough?

What is this course ?

Every year around 12,500 children aged 0-15 are injured whilst travelling in our cars.

UK Road Safety have pioneered a course primarily aimed at Child Carers such as Nannies, Au Pairs and Child Minders to educate them in not only driver awareness and ability but also the legal issues relating to driving and the personal safety issues relating to people who drive children around in cars.

Is there a test ?

Yes. To allow potential employers the chance to assess the ability of an employee the course is tested and graded:

- Fail—No Certificate
- Bronze—Competent
- Silver—Good Standard
- Gold—High Standard
- Gold Plus—Exceptionally High Standard

Is there a re-test ?

Yes , in order to retain a valid certificate, refresher training and re-testing is carried out every 2 years for Bronze, Silver and Gold Grades and every 3 years for the prestigious Gold Plus Award. This ensures that all qualified drivers are kept up to date with the latest in-car safety techniques and legislation.

What is included in the training ?

The course lasts 1 day and includes the following elements:

- Child Safety
- Drivers Legal Responsibilities
- Personal Safety
- Practical Driver Assessments & Training

Who are the instructors ?

A combination of Road Safety Officers, Advanced Driving Instructors and Approved Driving Instructors (ADI's) deliver the morning theory session.
