Why get Fleet Registered ?

To many Driving Instructors the driving instruction field stops at teaching learners. The fact is that the basic ADI badge should be seen as a 1st step in a far reaching and varied career.

The Road Safety Bill will bring with it an expansion of the Fleet Market due to increased knowledge of the need to manage Occupational Road Risks.

There is also a new DSA requirement that Continuing Professional Development can be fulfilled in this way.

One of the best reasons for getting yourself fleet registered is that it can increase your earning potential by allowing you to work in a number of other fields.

Who is it aimed at ?

The course is aimed at all ADI's who want to expand their career and explore all the opportunities that being on the fleet register can bring you.

It has also become a prerequisite for those ADI's wishing to become involved with the National Driver Improvement Scheme, MiDAS minibus training scheme and the governments SAFED van training programme amongst others.

Course Format

• Part 1 Theory Test

100 multiple choice questions - you must obtain an 85% pass mark to be successful in part 1.

• Part 2 Practical Driving Test

You will be asked to give both a driving commentary and also 2 instructional commentary's on a range of subjects from Roadcraft. Only 4 minor faults are allowed for part 2. Remember this is an advanced level test and lasts 1 hour.

• Part 3 Instructional and Coaching Test

This is where the examiner will play the part of a real client and simulate driving faults that you will be expected to pick up on and correct, the test is split into several sections it lasts 1 hour:

1. Client introduction, vehicle check and health and safety briefing.
2. Client Green Drive
3. Client debrief and fault analysis
4. Coaching session to correct identified faults
5. Final debrief and client assessment

Course Requirements for ADI's

- There is no need to have an advanced driving qualification, although it would be of significant benefit to you as the part 2 test of driving ability is an advanced level test.
- You will need to have a good knowledge of Roadcraft - The Police Drivers Handbook.
- You will need to have an awareness of Occupational Road Risk and the Fleet Market through research.

How long does the course last ?

The course is run on 2 formats

- Format 1 - 5 full consecutive days 08:45 - 16:30
- Format 2 - 5 consecutive weekdays run over 5 weeks 08:45 - 16:30
