Why get your drivers trained ?

Workplace transport is the second biggest cause of fatal incidents in British workplaces.

In 2000/01, 99 people were killed, 2,490 were seriously injured and 5,857 people sustained injuries which kept them off work for more than 3 days, all as a result of workplace transport incidents. The vast majority of these incidents were preventable.

If one of your drivers had a serious incident whilst driving for company business, regardless of whether it was a company vehicle or a private vehicle, you the employer have a duty of care to ensure that you have carried out adequate risk assessments and provided training.

Who is it aimed at ?

All employees who drive anywhere on company business are exposed to Road Risk regardless of how many miles they drive and in whose vehicle they drive those miles.

All companies that take Occupational Road Risks seriously need to talk to UK Road Safety, we can then help to steer you in the right direction to make sure that you have carried out your duty of care to your employees.

Work Related Road Safety - Employers Responsibilities

Some employers believe incorrectly that provided they comply with certain road traffic law requirements, such as ensuring that company vehicles have a valid MOT certificate, they are doing all that is necessary to ensure the safety of their employees when on the road.

Health & Safety Law requires employers and the self employed to ensure, so far as is reasonably practical, the health, safety and welfare of all employees, at all times. Employers also have a responsibility to ensure that others are not put at risk by the work activities of their employees.

Although the driver is ultimately responsible for how a vehicle is driven on the road the employer can have a significant influence on what the driver does.

For Example the imposition of unrealistic delivery schedules, inadequate training and failure to properly maintain vehicles all increase the risk of road incidents.

The Management of Health & Safety at Work Regulations 1999 require every employer to carry out an assessment of the risks to the health and safety of their employees, or themselves, whilst they are at work, and to other people who may be affected by their work activities. This includes any driving activity on the road. The regulations require the risk assessment to be reviewed periodically to ensure that it remains valid.

Employers should consider the risks to employees on the road in the same way as for those in a workplace.

What benefits are there to train ?

The benefits of carrying out a driver training programme are many and wide reaching, the main benefits are:

- **Fuel savings**, we encourage ECO driving. Driving in this style can use 10 to 15% less fuel.
- **Insurance savings**, after training, drivers are less likely to be involved in a collision. The less insurance claims you make, the cheaper your insurance will be.
- **Maintenance savings**, driving in a safe and fuel efficient manner will reduce the stress put on the vehicles, therefore reducing the number of breakdowns and in turn the maintenance costs.
- **Duty of care**, after you have started a training programme, you can rest assured that you are carrying out your duty of care to your employees. You will have identified risk areas and provided training in those areas.

How long does the course last ?

You can choose a format to suit your requirements and budgets, normally these courses are run over either a whole day or a half day.

Who Provides the Vehicles ?

Again, you have a choice, you can use our vehicles or we can carry out training in your vehicles, the choice is yours.

EXAMPLE PROGRAMME FORMAT

- Theory Session covering the following elements
 - The Risks we face
 - Attitude and Behaviour
 - Inappropriate speed
 - Fatigue and Stress
 - Drink/Drug Driving
 - Accident Analysis
 - Mobile Phones
 - Hard Hitting Video Clips
- On Road Car session Initial Assessment of each driver
- Driver Training (main areas from initial drive)
- Final Assessment reports written out with debrief for each driver

* Note that this can be run over 1 whole day or over a 1/2 day.
