What does attending the course involve ?

The course combines a mixture of driving theory with the latest thinking on defensive driving with modern training methods and practical, on-road driving under close supervision of an expert instructor.

How much will the course cost ?

The cost for the course is £187.00, payable before the beginning of the course. Please call if you wish to discuss payments details or options. All refreshments and lunch will be included.

How much training is on road ?

Actual driving times may vary, but you will be trained by an instructor, who holds advanced qualifications, for about six hours. Some of this time will be as a passenger watching another person behind the wheel as there are up to three trainees per car.

Courses will take place on a regular basis at several locations throughout the Avon & Somerset Constabulary Region:

- **Bristol** You may also request to undertake the course at any other location in the country near to your home.
- **Taunton**
- **Wells** Course fees will vary.

Is a car provided ?

Yes. A modern manual car, fully insured, is provided for the course; automatic transmission is also available on request.

Motorcyclists are also catered for on the same basis as above (motorcycles can be provided if necessary)

How long will the course last ?

The course lasts for a day and a half.

The first session is a full day and the second session is on the morning following the first session.

Courses are available throughout the week lasting a full day and a half.

However, course days are dependent upon venue.

Who are the instructors ?

For the theory session a combination of Road Safety Officers and Driving Instructors deliver the morning session.

For the practical session you will be Approved Driving Instructors specially trained and selected by UK Road Safety Ltd. The content of the course has been devised in conjunction with Avon & Somerset Constabulary, but all UK Road Safety Ltd staff are civilians with a wealth of experience.
